The Tutwiler Clinic will conduct an infection control training upon orientation, and then annually there-after.

Purpose

The purpose of the Infection Control Policy is to provide guidelines for the clinical and nonclinical staff at Tutwiler Clinic, Inc. in the proper procedures to reduce infections and protect our patients.

The clinic has adopted the Infection Prevention for General Orientation "The ongoing Challenge" for initial staff orientation. Documented evidence of this training will be in the form of a true/false test and will be kept in each employees personnel file. Test is attached.


Annually, the clinic shall participate in an infection control in-service utilizing the attached presentation. Documented evidence of this training in the form of a multiple choice test with a score of 80% or higher will be kept in each employees personnel file. Test is attached.

Quality Control

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Annually, the clinic staff shall participate in an infection control in-service utilizing appropriate updated visuals. The topics of Blood Borne Pathogens and Effective Handwashing techniques are to be included. Documented evidence of this in-service will be kept in the in-service sign-in log book.

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
